

Investing for Success

Under this agreement for 2019
Lakes Creek State School will receive

\$76,027*

This funding will be used to:

- Facilitate growth in Year 3 to 5 relative gain to be greater than then the relative gain of the nation and Similar Queensland State Schools (SQSS).
- Improve the 2019 Year 3 cohort for reading above 400 mean scale score points.
- Support students at Lakes Creek State School in achieving a 'C 'or better in English (80%)
- Ensure that 80% of our Prep and Year 1 students are meeting age appropriate clusters on all critical aspects of the literacy continuum.
- Support the reduction in the amount of verified students on individual curriculum plans by the end of semester 2, 2019 and accessing an age appropriate curriculum with peers.
- Increase school attendance to +91% for the 2019 school year.
- Implement band scaling to support Indigenous students from an ESL background. Identified students will move at least one level in speaking, listening, reading and writing.
- Improve triangular Positive Behaviours for Learning (PBL) data for whole school: 85% in the green, 10% in the yellow, 5% or less in the red.

Our initiatives include:

- Conducting professional development around the 'Reading Process' and 'High Reliability Literacy Teaching Procedures (HRLTPs)' pedagogies developed by Professor John Munro to develop staff capabilities in delivering curriculum content using these pedagogies.
- Continuing to develop staff capabilities around the Sound, Speech, Pictures (SSP) phonemic awareness program.
- Developing staff capabilities around unit planning using the Universal Design for Learning framework.
- Providing professional development to staff to develop sound processes around roles and responsibilities through High Performing Schools and Dr Peter Stebbins.
- Increasing teacher aide support during literacy blocks enabling them to work with EAL/D students, students with disabilities and extension students.
- Working with principal advisor for I/EALD to embed band scaling in the school assessment and reporting framework.





Our school will improve student outcomes by:

- Providing focused literacy intervention through differentiated teaching and learning for each student with a learning support teacher and utilising increased teacher aide time in the school. **\$50 000**
- Developing teacher capability to use the Universal Design for Learning Framework, and embed the use of Individual Curriculum Plans across learning areas. **\$ 5 000**
- Building teacher capabilities by attending SSP and OneSchool workshops **\$10 000**
- Continuing to implement PBL framework and team capabilities through the High Performing Schools program. **\$ 8 000**
- Updating reading and literacy resources to engage students in learning activities and explicit instruction lessons. **\$ 3 027**
